





Proposal of activating a 'migrant Processing Plan' in the face of immigration emergency in Texas

State legislator Eddie Morales, representative of the city of Eagle Pass, has reacted to the immigration emergency with the initiative to implement a "Migrant Processing Plan" ensuring that it is a more humane, more productive initiative and that it is very beneficial for the state.

This program allows previously selected migrants to live and work in Texas for a period of three years and for which the migrant must pay a fee of \$2,000 upon entering the country. With this initiative, the migrant would receive an identification card that will allow them to travel throughout the state without fear of being deported, but they would have to maintain a stable job, remain in Texas at all times and not commit minor crimes. This is proposed in order to activate new immigrants in the Texas economic system and change the point of view of them.

The program will be presented at the state capitol, waiting for the request to be taken into account and evaluated, considering the benefit it will give to the state's economic system and to improve the conditions of migrants.

Can my family benefit from my T visa?

and if you are a victim of human trafficking.

Yes, in many cases, your family can benefit from your T Visa if you are a victim of human trafficking. The T Visa is designed to provide protection and support to victims of trafficking and this includes the ability to include certain eligible family members in your application.

Family members who can generally benefit from your T Visa include:

Spouse: Your spouse may be eligible to obtain a T Visa as a derivative of you.

unmarried, may also be eligible to obtain a T Visa as your derivatives. Parents: In some cases, your parents may be eligible if you are under 21 years old

Children under 21 years of age: Your children under 21 years of age, single and

Siblings under 18 years of age: If you are a victim of human trafficking and have siblings under 18 years of age, single and unmarried, they may be eligible to obtain a T Visa as your derivatives.

However, it is important to remember that each case is unique and must be evaluated individually. Additionally, the process for including family members in your T Visa application may require specific documentation and evidence to demonstrate relationship and eligibility. For this reason, it is advisable to seek specialized legal advice to ensure that you and your family comply with the
