



Number of deportations increases to almost 300 thousand in the last five months

Deportations of immigrants have reached record numbers in the United States, according to official data from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)

"Since May 12, we have expelled or returned more than 295,000 people to 152 countries," according to a statement from the DHS, also highlighting that it has "expelled or returned more families in the last four months than in any previous full fiscal year." Between May 12 and October 12, the deportations of 41,000 family members found on the southwest border and more than 17,000 non-Mexicans in Mexico were recorded.

The increase in returns of people to their countries of origin was achieved by the agreement between nations to accelerate the return and the doubling of ICE international removal flights from the first to the second half of fiscal year 2023.

Last week, President Joe Biden said that they would restart the deportations of Venezuelans who have entered the country irregularly and find themselves without a legal basis for their permanence.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can a person apply for VAWA after divorcing their abuser?

A divorced person may be eligible to file a VAWA self-petition if they have been a victim of domestic violence or abuse at the hands of their former U.S. citizen or permanent resident spouse.

VAWA recognizes that domestic violence can continue after a divorce or separation and continues to protect victims in those situations. To be eligible for a VAWA petition after divorce, the applicant must file the petition within a maximum of 2 years after the divorce, in addition to meeting the rest of the application requirements.
